Fishing competition commences from 6pm Friday evening, competing anglers are required to check in at Clearwater Caravan Park with Cudgewa Classic organisers and pick up their membership cards.

The Cudgewa Classic Fishing Competition is a catch and release competition targeting cod, brown trout, rainbow trout, redfin, yellow belly and European carp. European carp are a declared pest species and must not be released back into the water once caught. NSW fishing licencing requirements must be followed.
